Q1. Discuss the Consequences of American Revolution.

A. American Revolution

It was a political revolution carried by the 13 Colonised states of North America to gain freedom from British rule.

Consequences

> Political

- Americans gained freedom in 1787 and united together form a Nation called United States of America.
- Formation of a Republic which ended the Monarchical system of governance. The idea to choose a leader or ruler from among the common people emerged.
- A constitution was formed in which all the rules and regulation to be followed were laid down for the first time.

> Economic

- The restrictions imposed by the Britishers on the Industries were all removed, meaning now USA could produce its own goods and sell it independently anywhere.
- Trade with rest of the world was opened directly

for America. Navigation laws were formed according to the needs of US market.

> Social
