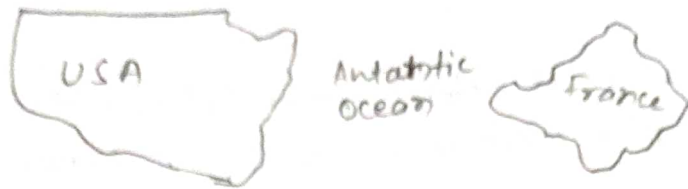


Ques Explain how the foundation of the modern world were laid by American and French Revolution.

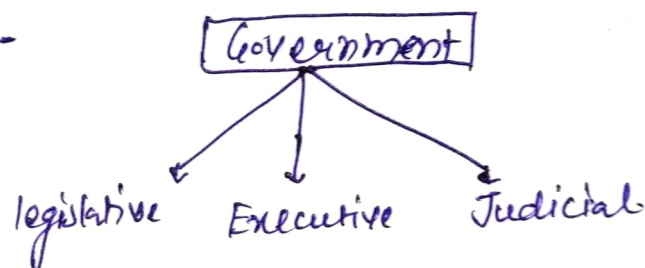
Ans American Revolution - The USA war of Independence fought between 13 Colonies of Britain with Britain on the continent of North America.
